4.0 Equipment Policy

The **Board of Fire Commissioners** must ensure that the resources provided for the protection of the residents and properties of the **Towns of Brookhaven and Riverhead** are utilized in the most effective manner. In addition the **Wading River Fire District** must consider the requirements of the **Suffolk County mutual aid plan** of which it is a member.

Thus all equipment that is the property of the **Wading River Fire District** is by priority committed to the lives and property of the residents of the **Towns of Brookhaven and Riverhead**. No equipment owned by the **Wading River Fire District** will be used in response to an emergency incident without official dispatch by the **Suffolk County Department of Emergency Response** or direct authorization of the Fire Chief.

All responses to emergencies outside of the **Wading River Fire District** are coordinated through the **Suffolk County Department of Emergency Response** and supervised by the Fire Chief.
