4.6 Equipment & Inspection of EMS Response Vehicles Policy

The Wading River Fire District is committed to providing the best possible care for all users of its EMS services. In order to meet this goal all EMS response vehicles must be properly equipped and inspected to insure such. The proper stocking and inspection of EMS Response Vehicles shall be undertaken by the employed EMS staff of the Fire District.

It is the policy of the Wading River Fire District that all EMS response vehicles meet New York State Department of Health equipment requirements. All EMS response vehicles shall be inspected on a regular basis to insure compliance. Inspection of EMS response vehicles shall occur at regularly scheduled ambulance checks and after each response. Any disposables used during a response shall be replaced at the hospital or upon return to quarters. At no time shall a Wading River Fire District EMS response vehicle operate when it does not meet N.Y.S. Compilation Codes, Rules and Regulations Section 800.24 titled Equipment Requirements for Certified Ambulance Service, N.Y.S. Dept. of Health and Suffolk County REMAC (Regional Emergency Medical Advisory Committee) equipment requirements.

Any discrepancies should be reported to a Department Officer and the District Manager.
